Qualifications:

Currently we are accepting applications for this role only in countries where we conduct programs. We are not accepting applications in US, Canada, Europe, or Australia.

To be eligible as a biomedical technician volunteer with Operation Smile, you must fulfill the following criteria:

- Knowledge and experience in biomedical, electronics, or mechanical; degree or C.B.E.T. certification preferred.
- Minimum of 1 year of experience in the operating room or a minimum of 3 years of experience in a non-operating room setting.
- Willingness and ability to attend and complete 3 phases of training.
- Background check as regulated by foundation office.

Application documents needed:

- Completed Operation Smile Application form.
- Curriculum vitae (resume) detailing current experience, in English.
- Certificate/degree in profession, as recognized by country of residence.
