

Leasy's Resilience

Sweet Leasy was born with a cleft lip and palate in Toamasina, Madagascar. His grandmother, Jeanette, has been a pillar of support and care for him since. "He was so tiny," she shared. "His parents have not been around, so I am the one who takes care of him."

Jeanette tried her best to care for her grandson, but Leasy struggled to feed due to his severe cleft palate. He was malnourished – getting weaker by the day.

Fortunately, Jeanette reached out to Operation Smile in Madagascar and found hope for her grandson's future. At Leasy's first medical evaluation, it was apparent that he would need nutritional care to help him gain the weight he would require for his first cleft surgery, and time was running out.

Your compassion and generosity meant Leasy received the life-saving nutritional care he needed. He's one of over 280 children enrolled in Operation Smile's Nutrition Program in Madagascar.

The program provides children like Leasy and their families with monthly nutritional boxes, including baby formula, specialized cleft feeding bottles, and nutritional supplements.


With support from Operation Smile and his grandmother's loving care, little Leasy gained 100 grams in just two days! He will receive his first life-changing cleft surgery when he reaches a healthy weight.

"I've wondered how I'd be able to take care of my grandson. I've been very worried," says Jeanette. "I was searching for information on how to feed him. I'm so thankful I found Operation Smile and appreciate you taking care of my grandson."

THE NEXT DECADE OF LOVE AND LEADERSHIP

Launching our "Next Decade" plans, ensuring a million more patients receive access to the surgery and care they need - closer to where they live - is well underway.

Initial plans for this first year project close to 65,000 patients to receive clinical care, as well as thousands of global medical volunteers benefitting from Operation Smile's education and training programs.

To achieve these long-range goals, our major focus is being placed on medical education to ensure we maximize the volume and quality of training in all clinical programs (surgery, nursing, etc.).

Clinical Care programs are currently running 94% to plan, with minor delays in only a few countries. Oral Health programs are exceeding the plan by 12% due to expanding capacity at our care centres.

Our Nutrition programs in Madagascar, Guatemala, and Peru have surpassed by 11%. Operation Smile's Co-Founder, Dr. Bill Magee, is the first to explain that the surgeon is only 10% of the solution for a child born with a cleft condition. Through delivering complete (preand post-surgical) care, with a constant focus on quality training and medical education, more patients will be helped.

While economic issues, including inflation, currency devaluation, and other local issues, are ever-present, we will not lose focus on the fact that every three minutes, a child is born with a cleft lip, cleft palate, or both. With donors, partners, and our global team of dedicated medical volunteers on these children's side, we will help more patients in more places than ever before. A million more.



Álvaro's Story of Compassion

"He was unprotected, and I had the chance to help him. I felt like it was what I needed to do," nurse Mónica del Valle reminisces about adopting baby Álvaro as her own. He was born with a cleft lip and cleft palate and sadly, his family abandoned him at the hospital where Mónica worked.

Mónica knew the road ahead for Álvaro would not be an easy one. Fortunately, she was referred to Operation Smile in Paraguay by a specialist. Álvaro soon began receiving the vital care he needed for his first cleft surgery.

Mónica's compassion transformed Álvaro's future - and so has yours. As an Operation Smile partner, you've helped Mónica get her new son the cleft surgery and comprehensive care he needs to thrive. In September 2019, our global medical volunteers repaired Álvaro's cleft lip. He continued to receive follow-up cleft care until he was ready for his cleft palate surgery.

Pure compassion is the overwhelming factor that drove Mónica, our global medical volunteers, and YOU to deliver life-changing and vital cleft care to children around the world.

Tong Xuan Nguyen's Bright Future

When Tong Xuan Nguyen was born with a cleft lip, his father wasn't afraid. He also lived with a cleft condition for most of his life.

His father wanted him to receive the cleft care he needed much earlier than he did. So, he reached out to Operation Smile in Vietnam, trusting that his son's life would soon look different from his own.

His father's hope for a better future for him was realized because of partners like you who continue to strengthen Operation Smile worldwide and enable us to deliver complete cleft care with integrity.

Today, father and son share the same joyful and beautiful smile. Tong Xuan Nguyen was one of 57 patients who received life-changing cleft surgeries and vital follow-up care in Hanoi this October.

A total of 118 children were screened during the surgical program. Despite heavy rains, the program exceeded its



IMPACT in South Africa

In October 2022, the first surgical program in over two years resumed at Nelson Mandela Academic Hospital in Mthatha in the Eastern Cape. Our medical volunteers were eager to return to what they did best - delivering beautiful smiles and making an impact in the lives of children born with cleft conditions.

The team (including plastic surgeons, nurses, doctors, dentists, and speech therapists) worked together to conduct surgeries and deliver follow-up assessments and comprehensive care.

Twenty-two children and one young adult received life-changing cleft surgeries during the surgical program.

In the Dominican Republic, Operation Smile celebrated a milestone at the end of 2022 with its 30th international surgical program in Santiago. Since 2009, dedicated partners like you have helped provide more than 1,550 cleft surgeries in the Dominican Republic.

Our global team, including Canadian volunteers, delivered an incredible 45 cleft surgeries over four days, surpassing our initial surgical goal by more than 12 percent.


