Qualifications

In order to be eligible as a speech language pathologist volunteer with Operation Smile, you must fulfill the following criteria:

- Hold a degree and licensure in Speech Language Pathology or its equivalent certification within a country.
- Clinically competent in cleft lip and cleft palate and other craniofacial syndromes.
 - Current experience with cleft patients for the last three (3) years.
- Ability to educate counterparts.

Application documents needed:

- Completed Speech Language Pathology application online, including three references.
- Copy of resume/curriculum vitae detailing current experience.
- Copies of diplomas and degrees.
- Copy of current license/registration in field (as applicable by country).
- Copy of current Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-Language Pathology (as applicable by country; for US volunteers CCC-SLP required).
